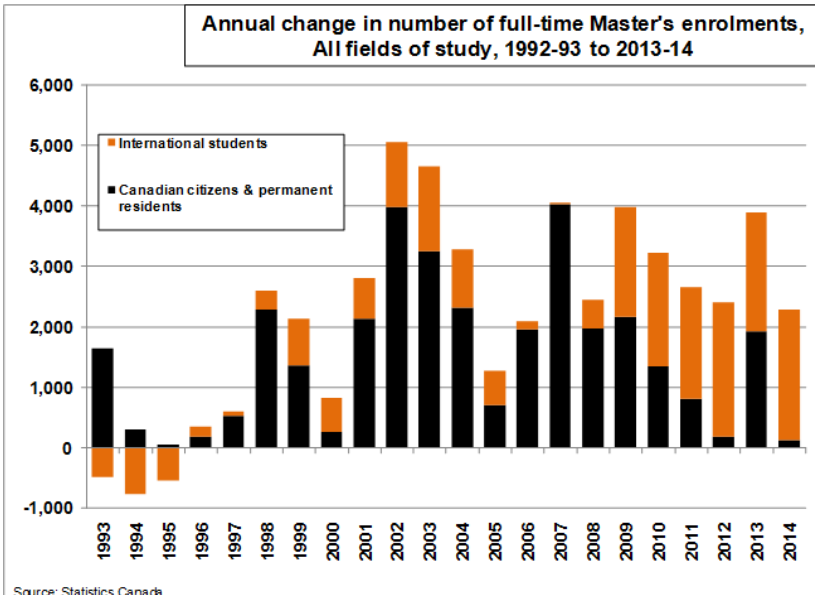

Most graduate enrolment growth in Canada has been from international enrolments.

From 2009 to 2014, there was an overall increase of 14,502 full-time Master's enrolments, and 5,973 full-time doctoral enrolments.

69% of the increase in full-time Master's enrolments (10,077 enrolments) was from international enrolments.

Almost all (96% or 5,709) of the increase in full-time doctoral enrolments were international.

Canadian citizens and permanent residents dominate the increases in full-time Master's enrolments in Health and Related fields.

Almost all the increase in full-time Master's enrolments in Architecture, Engineering & Related has been from international enrolments.



**TOP FIELDS OF STUDY FOR INTERNATIONAL
FULL-TIME MASTER'S/DOCTORAL STUDENTS**

Main fields of study with consistent increases in international Master's enrollments:

Architecture, Engineering & Related; Business, Management & Public Relations; Social & Behavioural Sciences & Law.

Main fields of study with consistent increases in doctoral enrolments:

Physical & Life Sciences & Technologies; and Architecture, Engineering & Related.
