

## **CAGS-ProQuest Distinguished Dissertation Awards**

A Comprehensive Checklist

- □ A letter of support from the Dean of Graduate Studies, which also includes the following information:
  - i. A description of the process used to select the nominee;
  - ii. The name and departmental affiliation of the nominee's research supervisor;
  - iii. The name and affiliation of the external examiner;
  - iv. The date of the defence and the date of final acceptance of the dissertation by the Graduate School.<sup>1</sup>
- □ A letter from the student's supervisor or program director describing the reasons for the nomination, and why the dissertation constitutes a significant piece of original work.
- □ A copy of the external examiner's pre-defence report. The examiner's report must be dated and signed or otherwise authenticated by the Dean of Graduate Studies.
- □ An abstract of the dissertation, not exceeding 350 words, written by the candidate in non-technical language.<sup>2</sup>
- $\Box$  An up-to-date c.v. of the nominee.
- □ The name and coordinates of the person to contact for questions relating to the nomination.

 $<sup>^{2}</sup>$  The candidate should also be aware of their nomination for the award and provide the information in items 4 and 5; should this not be possible, the reasons must be given in the letter from the dean.
